The State FFA Convention was held May 4 – May 6 at the Ohio Expo Center. Members travelled to Columbus after school on May 4th to check into the hotel and have an evening of recreation at Magic Mountain. On Thursday, May 5th the Chapter attended Sydney Snider's workshop on Destination AWESOME. In this workshop students learned to develop their strengths and how to help others.

Friday of the Convention was a busy day, with three general sessions and a number of workshops to choose from. During the Third Session Brooklyn Farmer, student advisor and Brianna Baldwin accepted a Gold Medal Chapter Award on behalf of the Chapter. President, Joe McElwee and Vice President, Katie Cora accepted the award for Ohio FFA top ten chapter development. Secretary, Jordan Crum, and Treasurer C.J. Smart accepted the award for Ohio's FFA top 10 chapter. After this session, and practices, members had lunch on the Convention grounds and attended leadership workshops. During the Fourth Session in the afternoon we celebrated all the hard work put in by Secretaries, Treasurers, and Reporters from around the state – including the very own from our chapter! To earn a gold medal rating on Officer Books they must be thoroughly completed using the guidelines provided. Receiving Gold Rated Officer Books were: Jordan Crum, secretary's award, C.J. After the Fourth Session members were given time to explore the Career and Trade Show, the Agriscience Fair, displays of Proficiency Award Finalists, and to meet with other members from around the state! 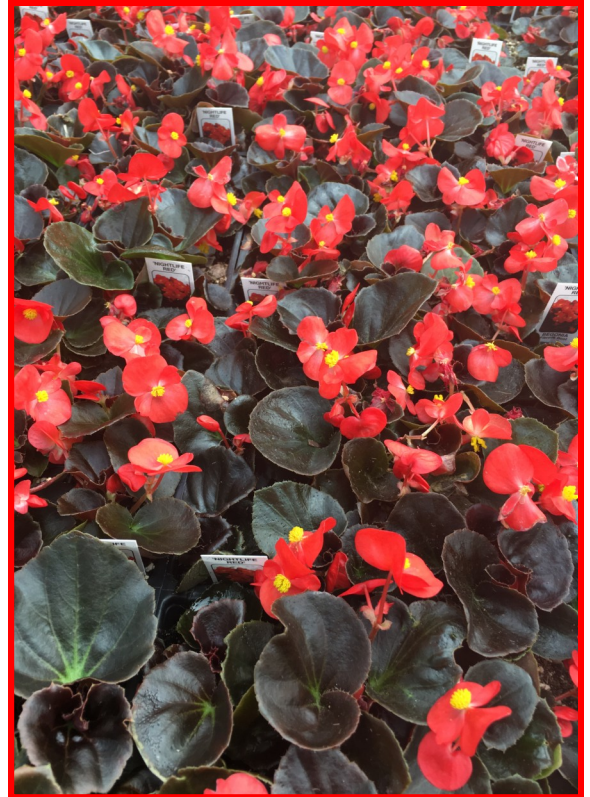
