Convention is the Fifth, and final, Session. Not only did members listen to State President, Mary Buehler give her retiring address, they were



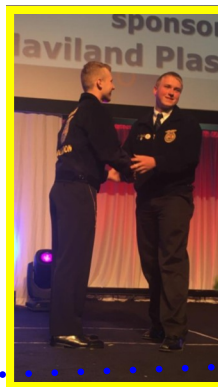
