To whom it may concern:

You are receiving this letter because you may have one or more students who meet the eligibility requirements for a Hagan Scholarship. I hope you will encourage these students to apply for a scholarship. The award of a Hagan Scholarship can be life changing and will provide each recipient with the opportunity to graduate college debt free.

The Hagan Scholarships are intended for high achieving students who will require financial assistance in order to attend college. About one-half of our recipients are first in family to attend college, or have a zero EFC. Each scholarship is worth up to \$40,000; the average dollar amount disbursed over four years is over \$24,000. Two-Thirds of Finalists interviewed are awarded Hagan Scholarships. Finalists interviewed and not awarded a scholarship receive \$1,000. Hagan Scholars currently attend one hundred forty-seven different colleges and universities. The Free Workshops; \$10,000 Schwab Accounts; and Study Abroad Awards are integral parts of the Hagan Scholarship and are designed to help recipients obtain a practical understanding of important life skills not usually taught as a part of the school curriculum. To learn more, visit our website.
