STRANGE BREW: Bob and Doug McKenzie, a.k.a. Rick Moranis and Dave Thomas from the satiric "SCTV," are the dimly lit, brothers just out for a good time with their beloved donuts and beer. But they discover a fiendish plot by mad scientist Max von Sydow and must save civilization as we know it. A gentle, goofball comedy.

THE GOLDEN SEAL: A young boy (Torquil Campbell) befriends a rare golden seal, protecting it from all manner of predators. Shades of "Lassie" mixed with a strong Save the Seals message.

RETURN OF THE JEDI: Luke Sky-walker and the rebel forces face the evil Empire for a final confrontation in this third "Star Wars' epic. With monsters, new fuzzy heroes, and interminable chases.
