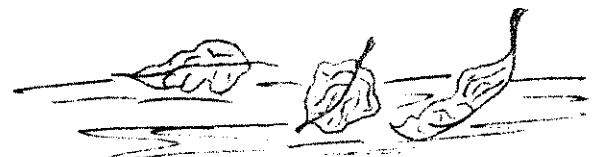

# MOVIE REVIEWS

The PHS Times rates films in numbers from one to five. Five means excellent; One means poor.

STRANGE BREW: Bob and Doug McKenzie, a.k.a. Rick Moranis and Dave Thomas from the satiric "SCTV," are the dimly lit, brothers just out for a good time with their beloved donuts and beer. But they discover a fiendish plot by mad scientist Max von Sydow and must save civilization as we know it. A gentle, goofball comedy.

RATING IS 3

THE GOLDEN SEAL: A young boy (Torquil Campbell) befriends a rare golden seal, protecting it from all manner of predators. Shades of "Lassie" mixed with a strong 'Save the Seals' message.

RATING IS 2

EASY MONEY: Rodney Dangerfield stars as sleazy Monty Capuletti, a slob who must drop all his beloved bad habits within a year for his family to inherit his mother-in-law's \$10 million inheritance. In this film, Dangerfield is a funny man saddled with mostly plodding, tasteless material.

RATING IS 2

THE STAR CHAMBER: A thoughtful, well-crafted drama that asks questions about our legal system and the extent to which some well-intentioned jurists will step outside it, and the Constitution, to re-establish law and order. A fine, restrained performance by Michael Douglas, a sage, witty one by Hal Holbrook.

RATING IS 5

RETURN OF THE JEDI: Luke Skywalker and the rebel forces face the evil Empire for a final confrontation in this third "Star Wars" epic. With monsters, new fuzzy heroes, and interminable chases.

RATING IS 3

MR. MOM: Micheal Keaton and Teri Garr star in this predictable role-reversal comedy, bringing more humor and life to the story than its script deserves. The situation is strictly TV sitcom, but the performances are charming.

RATING IS 2

RISKY BUSINESS: Tom Cruise stars as a preppy high school senior left alone with his parents' posh house, cars and \$125. What trouble he doesn't devise for himself his school pals and newfound hooker friend create for him. A stylishly photographed comedy with a heart of pure mercenary free enterprise.

RATING IS 3

NATIONAL LAMPOON'S VACATION: Nothing uproariously funny in this satire of the station-wagoned family vacation, but enough laughs to keep the show on the road. With Chevy Chase as the square, preppy father, Beverly D'Angelo as mom and Anthony Michael Hall and Dana Barron as the squabbling kids.
