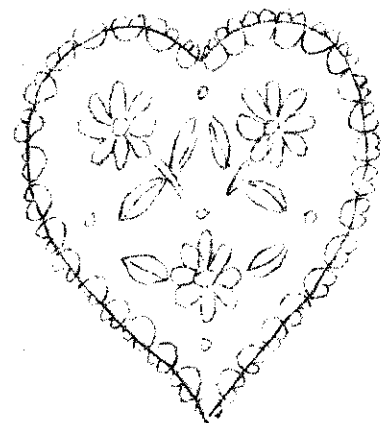

MOVIE REVIEWS

SILKWOOD: Meryl Streep takes a subtle and understated approach to the part of Karen Silkwood in a movie based on the life of a nuclear fuel plant technician who blew the whistle on safety violations.
rated: (R)

TWO of a KIND: John Travolta and Olivia Newton-John in a clever little romantic comedy. God is disgusted with humanity and has decided to put an end to the world, but four angels convince him to lay off if a mismatched couple (John Travolta and Olivia Newton-John) turn out okay. Old fashioned but charming, in the manner of those '40s movies with guardian angels dabbling in human affairs.
rated: (PG)

GORKY PARK: It's too cluttered to be as taut as a good murder mystery ought to be, but at least this story about a triple murder in a Moscow park has William Hurt. Hurt, as a Russian detective, keeps the tale on its legs long after it would have stumbled in Moscow's slush and the weaving plotline.
rated (R)

BEST FRIENDS: The near-perfect relationship of two scriptwriters is almost demolished by their marriage.

THE ROAD WARRIOR: Members of a futuristic society fight for survival in a fuel-starved era.

THE MAN WHO LOVED WOMEN: The pivotal moment is when a displaced mirror allows Burt Reynolds to look up Julie Andrews dress. That should give you some idea of the mentality of this movie, which purports to be a study of a man who loves women so much that he has become an ineffectual neurotic. Sporadically funny, but mostly just as stupid as it sounds.
rated (R)

TO BE OR NOT TO BE: Mel Brooks is surprisingly tame in this comedy about a troupe of actors in Warsaw during the Nazi takeover in World War II. A remake of the '40s movie starring Jack Benny and Carol Lombard; well-crafted but strangely punchless.
rated (PG)

D.C. CAB: Sophomoric humor about a group of miscreant cab drivers. Has a few clever moments, but it's mostly a hack job. rated (R)

SCARFACE: Without the talents of Al Pacino and director Brian De Palma, this would have been a so-so shoot 'em up. But Pacino makes his drug-dealing, gun wielding character something more than a trigger finger. His performance is both explosive and somehow intimate, and De Palma's violent choreography verges on the surreal.
rated (R)

CHARIOTS OF FIRE: Two exceptional runners compete in the 1924 Paris Olympics, spurred on by their personal needs to excel.

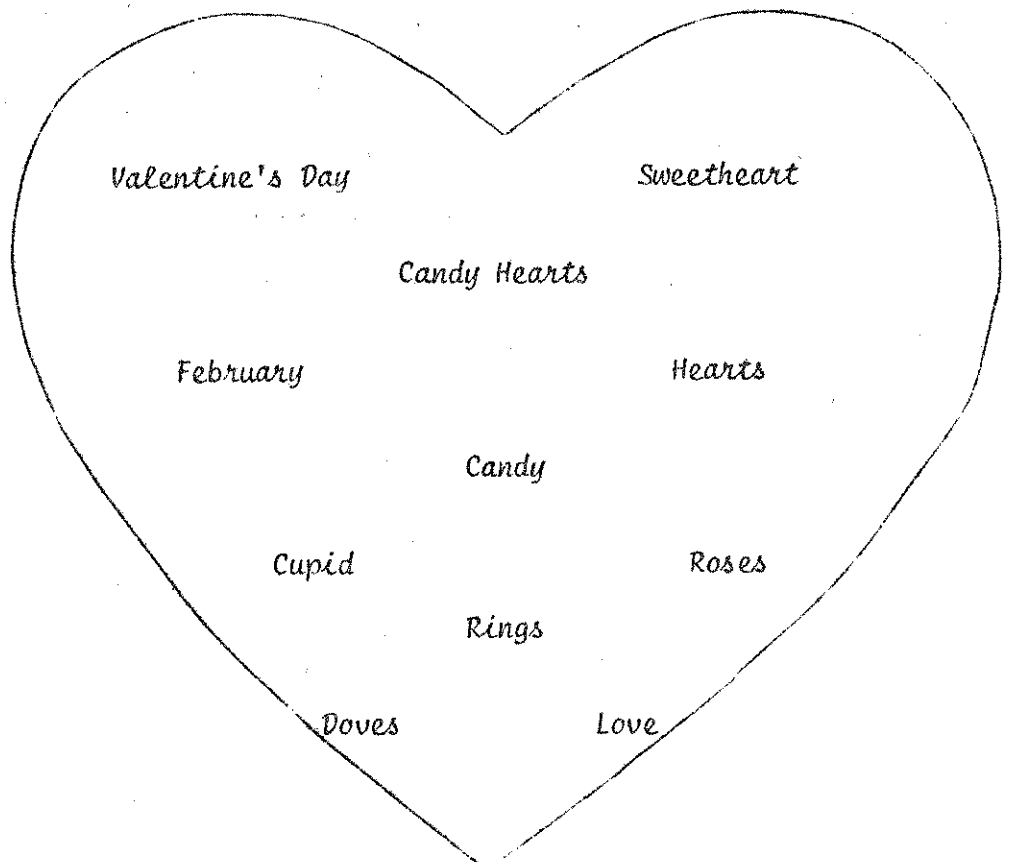
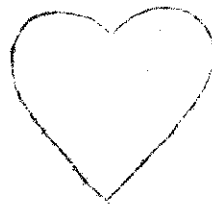
