On Tuesday, December 18th, the Club went to King's Island Winterfest for a lovely day.

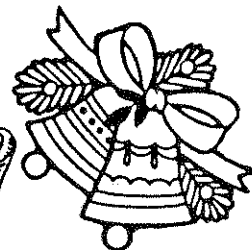
During the last meeting two candidates were voted on to represent the club as a nominee for State Beta President. Congratulations to Matt Sanders, the winner.

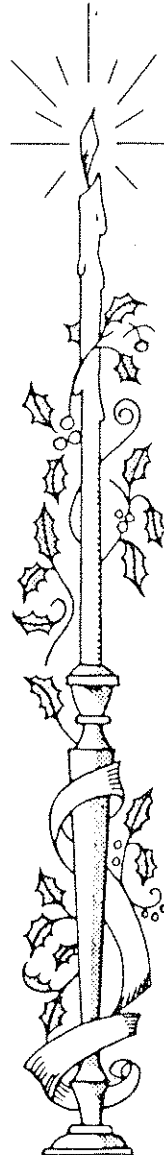

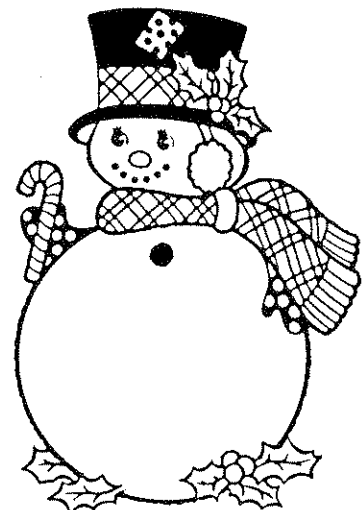

3. Eat quickly!!!

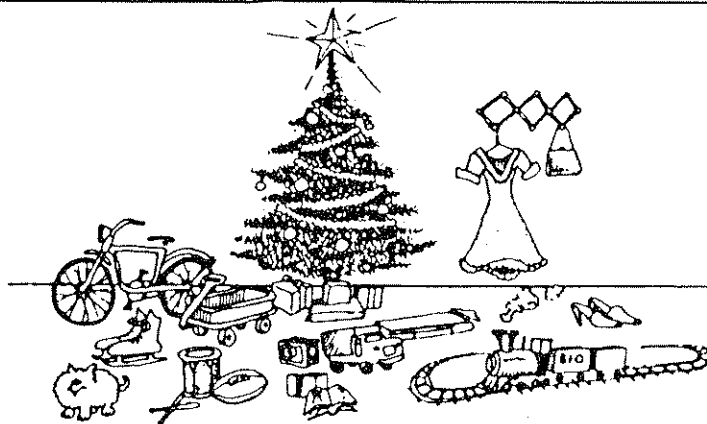
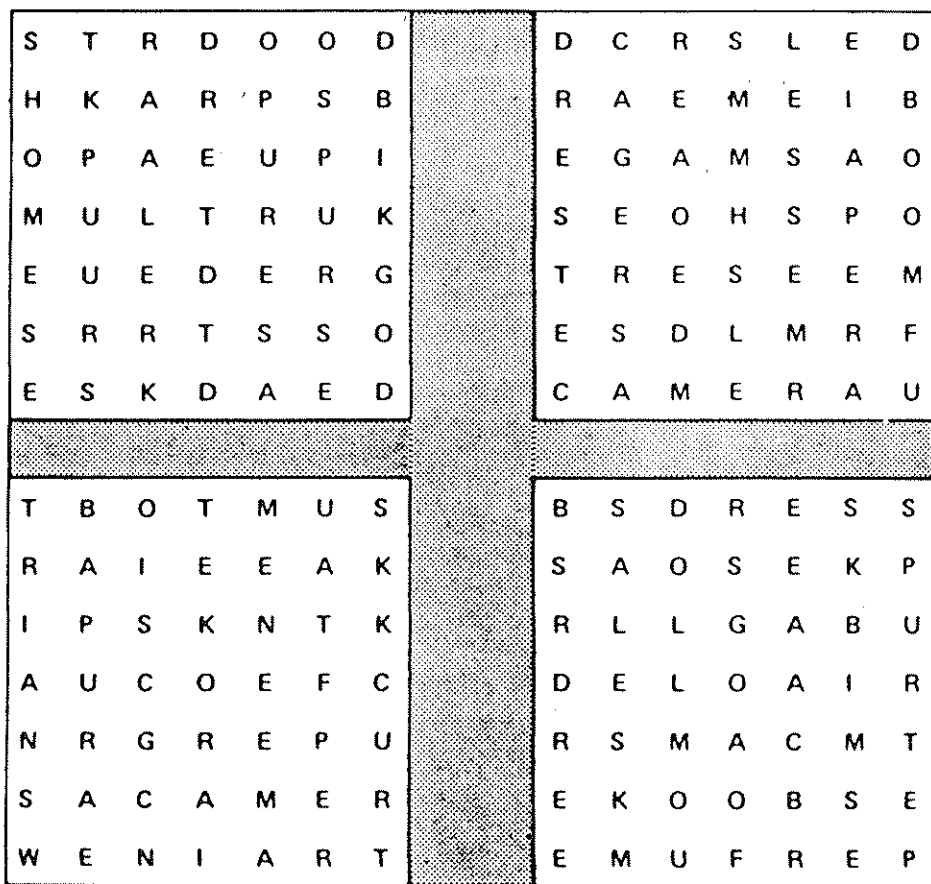
